- 2) CA Dept of Food & Ag CUSP \$94,214 Aid for underserved farmer and ranchers to provide technical assistance and outreach. Short term interns and contractors may be hired to assist with program.
- N. CARCD/CDFA SWEEP & NRCS/AFT Healthy Soils for diverse small growers

Justin Morgan and Gurbiner Kang (SRCD) have been working on launching this program. Justin been at SRCD for two months now and have a list of 43 growers in Fresno County who have received funding from CDFA in 2019, for drip irrigation system improvements. SRCD's role is to identify if they have completed their enhancement and efficiency projects and see if they are interested in evaluation, with distribution uniformity testing. They are also working on identifying farmers who are growers who have traditionally not have had access to these kinds of programs. A lot of growers haven't completed their projects, some are not calling back yet. First on site visit happened last month, a young and new farmer, who might be interested in the evaluation phase. Justin and Gurbinder are working on making connections or relationship through the UCCE and NRCS with the growers they are actively engaged with. Gurbinder to help with the association of Punjabi farmers in Fresno. Outreach for SWEEP testing and project improvement for conservation practices.
