The California Department of Housing and Community Development is providing funding through its ReCoverCA Housing Programs to homeowners affected by FEMA-declared 2020 disasters, including the Creek Fire. Homeowners that have yet to rebuild may be eligible for **up to \$500,000 to repair and reconstruct their homes.**

**This event may be of interest to you if you had previously applied but were denied due to income limits.*
